

# On This Rock I will “Change” My Church

(Spoken to MB April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014)



## Daniel 2:34-35

<sup>34</sup> As you looked, a Stone was cut out without human hands, which smote the image on its feet of iron and baked clay of the potter and broke them to pieces.

<sup>35</sup> Then the iron, the baked clay of the potter the bronze, the silver, and the gold were broken and crushed together and became like the chaff of the summer threshing floors, and the wind carried them away so that not a trace of them could be found. And the Stone that smote the image became a great mountain or rock and filled the whole earth.

<sup>45</sup> Just as you saw that the Stone was cut out of the mountain without hands and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold, the great God has made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter. The dream is certain and the interpretation of it is sure.

## Matthew 21:42-44

<sup>42</sup> Jesus asked them... Have you never read in the Scriptures: The very Stone which the builders rejected and threw away has become the Cornerstone; this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes.

<sup>43</sup> I tell you, for this reason the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce the fruits of it.

<sup>44</sup> And whoever falls on this Stone will be broken to pieces, but he on whom It falls will be crushed to powder and It will winnow him, scattering him like dust.
